

SEEKING HOST FAMILIES FOR OUR TWO SOWETO STUDENTS

For more than a decade our student leaders have been actively promoting the wonderful relationship we have with our sister school, Letsibogo Girls High School in Soweto, South Africa.

Each year Frankston High School sponsors a student from Letsibogo and provides her with the opportunity of experiencing life and learning in a privileged environment that offers opportunities they may otherwise never experience, which they utilise with success when they return to South Africa.

The student is selected according to her potential to graduate from school and progress with further tertiary learning and a fulfilling career. This year we will be sponsoring two students- Karabo Mabala (16 years old) and Puseletso Mathambeka (17 years old).

After arrival both of the girls will be staying together to settle in with one of our biggest Soweto Host Family Program supporters, Trudy Poole. Then from Saturday 4 May we will require Frankston High School families to host.

We are seeking FHS families to host one of our Letsibogo Girls' High School students for a period of approximately 4 weeks or longer by request. They will be completing Year 11 at Frankston High School.

Daily needs such as clothing and toiletries and other needs such as hairdresser, pre pay mobile phone, public transport costs plus a \$30 per week allowance are provided by the school. However, we would be relying on the generosity of host families to provide accommodation and food.
