

SCHOOL UNIFORM 7-10 CAMPUS



The Frankston High School uniform requirements are described below and are outlined very clearly in the student diary. We ask parents to please support us in enforcing this policy. All uniforms should be purchased from the Uniform Shop, (located 7-10 Campus) to ensure the correct uniform is bought. We cannot take responsibility for incorrect items of uniform purchased elsewhere. Complete school uniform, including school shoes, must be worn throughout the school year, from the first day to the last. Uniform must have the Frankston High School Logo. GENERAL RULES ON UNIFORM

- Uniform must always be clean, neat and in good condition.
- The school uniform is compulsory for all students and must be worn at school, while travelling to and from school, and on any school excursion except where the teacher in charge has obtained the approval of the Assistant Principal for other clothes to be worn and this is noted on the Consent Form. All uniform items should be clearly named for identification.
- The full Frankston High School **uniform must be worn** from the first day of the school year until the last. Please do not ask for exemptions, particularly in regard to school shoes.
- A plain white t-shirt, no logos, can be worn under the uniform shirt for extra warmth. It should not be visible at the sleeves or the bottom of the shirt. No other colour is acceptable.
- **Jewellery:** Is not to be worn apart from a watch (**smart watches not acceptable**) and, for students with pierced ears, a pair of simple studs or sleepers in the ear lobes only (one per ear). Ear stretches are not acceptable and not to be worn. No earrings or studs are to be worn in the nose, eyebrow, upper ear or any other part of the anatomy. Using clear plastic earrings or covering them with a band-aid **is not acceptable**.
- **Makeup:** Students are not permitted to wear make-up, false eyelashes, nail polish or false nails. Tattoos must be covered at all times.
- **Footwear:** The required shoes for boys and girls are the **plain flat, black, polished, lace-up hard leather shoes** (Oxford style). Elevated heels are not allowed. Black suede shoes, soft leather shoes, t-bar shoes, ballet shoes, slip-on shoes, boots, shoes with zippers, shoes like 'Vans', skate shoes or runners are **not** regarded as acceptable footwear, do not meet our safety requirements and **must not** be worn by students in Years 7-10. Under no circumstances can students participate in workshop classes without correct school shoes, even though they may have a Uniform Pass. School shoes which can accommodate orthotics can be purchased from a variety of shoe shops in Frankston. **Thongs must NEVER be worn at school, even on Casual Dress Day.**
- **Hair:** Must be kept regularly washed and in a healthy state. Hair grooming, styling and colouring must be appropriate to a school setting. Coloured hair must be a natural colour. No extremes will be accepted including dreadlocks, bright hair dyes, shaved heads, pointed spikes, rat tails, mohawks, shaved patterns, dipped dyed hair or ombre coloured hair.
- Students in Years 7-10 must be **clean shaven; no beards or moustaches**.
- Frankston High School **navy baseball cap** with the school logo is acceptable and must be worn outside for sun protection. Plain navy bucket hats or broad brim hats with no writing, logos or decorations are acceptable. No other hats or beanies are acceptable.
- Coloured jackets of any description are not to be worn over the school uniform, either at school or while travelling to or from school. Only the navy jacket with the Frankston High School logo is acceptable.
- Windcheaters are not to be worn over or under school uniform. Hoodies are not to be worn on any occasion at school.
- **School bags:** The only school bags to be permitted will be plain navy backpacks with no writing, logos or decorations. The Uniform Shop stocks suitable bags; however, any plain navy backpack will be acceptable. **Absolutely no graffiti on school bags allowed.**
- Frankston High School sports uniform or any other special sport program uniform can only be worn during the activity and not during normal classes.

GIRLS UNIFORM (Years 7-10)

- Girls are **not to wear a combination** of summer and winter uniforms, e.g. winter tights cannot be worn with the summer dress.
- Girls must wear **summer uniform** in Term 1 and after Melbourne Cup Day in Term 4.
- Girls must wear **winter uniform** after the Queen's Birthday Holiday until the end of Term 3.
- Either summer or winter uniform, but not a combination, can be worn during Term 2 until the Queen's Birthday and in Term 4 until Melbourne Cup Day.
- The approved school trouser/shorts with the school logo are part of both summer and winter uniform.

- Make-up, false eyelashes, nail polish and false nails are not to be worn and students will be required to remove them.
- Hair colour must be a natural colour.
- Hair ribbons/scrunchies — blue, white, yellow or school check.
- **Plain flat, black polished, lace-up hard leather shoes** (Oxford style). Elevated heels are not allowed. Black suede shoes, soft leather shoes, t-bar shoes, ballet shoes, slip-on shoes, boots, shoes with zippers, shoes like 'Vans', skate shoes or runners are **not** regarded as acceptable footwear, do not meet our safety requirements, and **must not** be worn by students in Years 7-10. Under no circumstances can students participate in workshop classes without correct school shoes, even though they may have a Uniform Pass. School shoes which can accommodate orthotics can be purchased from a variety of shoe shops in Frankston. **Things must NEVER be worn at school, even on Casual Dress Day.**

Summer

- School gingham dress with the school logo. Hem length must be no shorter than 5cm as measured from the ground when kneeling.
- Navy trousers with the school logo.
- Navy shorts with the school logo available by special order.
- Blue shirts with the school logo.
- The authorised woollen school jumper, 'Williamstown Blue' and with the school logo.
- Navy plain socks, knee-high and ankle length (above the ankle). Socks must not have logos.
- Navy jacket with the school logo (can be worn over the jumper).

Winter

- School tartan skirt with the school logo. Hem length must be no shorter than 5cm as measured from the ground when kneeling.
- Blue shirt with the school logo to be worn under jumper.
- The authorised woollen school jumper, 'Williamstown Blue' and with the school logo.
- Knee length navy socks or navy tights may be worn. Socks and tights cannot be worn together. Socks must not have logos.
- Navy scarves
- Navy jacket with the school logo (can be worn over the jumper).

BOYS UNIFORM (Years 7-10)

General Wear

- Grey trousers and shorts with the school logo.
- Blue shirt with the school logo.
- The authorised woollen school jumper, 'Williamstown Blue' and with the school logo.
- Plain grey/black belts only, to be secured by belt loops.
- Grey socks (above the ankle). Socks must not have logos.
- Navy scarves
- Navy jacket with the school logo (can be worn over the jumper).
- **Plain flat, black polished, lace-up hard leather shoes** (Oxford style). Elevated heels are not allowed. Black suede shoes, soft leather shoes, t-bar shoes, ballet shoes, slip-on shoes, boots, shoes with zippers, shoes like 'Vans', skate shoes or runners are **not** regarded as acceptable footwear, do not meet our safety requirements, and **must not** be worn by students in Years 7-10. Under no circumstances can students participate in workshop classes without correct school shoes, even though they may have a Uniform Pass. School shoes which can accommodate orthotics can be purchased from a variety of shoe shops in Frankston. **Things must NEVER be worn at school, even on Casual Dress Day.**

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students are not permitted to participate in PE/Sport unless in correct sport uniform

Year 7 2021 students to commence with the new sport uniform. (Shorts, with yellow piping, and white polo shirt to be phased out).

- Frankston High School navy shorts with the school logo.
- Frankston High School navy polo shirt with the school logo.
- White sports socks. Socks must not have logos.
- Lace up runners or gym boots with non-marking soles. Slip on shoes are not permitted.
- Frankston High School tracksuit pants, 2XUs and rugby tops (all with school logo) are also permitted during PE/sport and are available from the Uniform Shop.
- Navy jacket with the school logo.
- Frankston High School navy baseball cap or plain navy bucket hat/broad brim hat (with no writing, logos or decorations) for sun protection to be worn outdoors only.
- **Absolutely no fluro, stripes or flashes on any garment.**
